 *Very dry, delicate, light white*

- 1. **San Floriano Pinot Grigio, Venezia, Italy** **£5.50** **£7.00** **£21.00**
 Delicate flavours of apples and pears on a refreshingly dry palate.

- 2. **Denbies Flint Valley, England** **£23.00**
 A lively nose of lime zest and ripe pear leads to a fresh and vibrant citrus palate with good minerality and well balanced acidity.

- 3. **Gavi Ca' Bianca, Italy** **£27.00**
 White flower and green fruit aromas, with a touch of honey and refreshing minerality on the palate.

 *Dry, herbaceous or aromatic white*

- 4. **Monte Verde Sauvignon Blanc** **£5.00** **£6.50** **£19.00**
Central Valley, Chile
 Classic gooseberry flavours enhanced by tropical fruit and zesty lemon.

- 5. **Quinta das Arcas Arca Nova Branco,** **£5.75** **£7.50** **£22.00**
Vinho Verde, Portugal
 Green apple and sweet pear with a touch of spritz on the finish.

- 6. **Southern Rivers Sauvignon Blanc** **£6.50** **£8.50** **£25.00**
Marlborough, New Zealand
 Fresh and crisp with classic characters of gooseberry and tropical flavours.

- 7. **Nederburg The Beautiful Lady** **£7.25** **£9.50** **£28.00**
Gewurztraminer, Stellenbosch, South Africa
 The wine is rich, with the sweetness is well tempered by the acidity: shows pronounced aromas of rose, lychee and pineapple.

- 8. **Pouilly-Fumé, Cuvée du Troncsec, Joseph Mellot, France** **£33.00**
 Loire Sauvignon Blanc at its best, classic gunflint and rich gooseberries on the nose, creamy fullness on the palate and a crisp, dry finish.

 *Juicy, fruit-driven, ripe white*

- 9. **Kleine Zalze Vineyard Selection Chenin Blanc,** **£24.00**
Stellenbosch, South Africa
 Ripe and silky-smooth, from South Africa's most popular white grape variety with rich guava fruit and honeyed character.

- 10. **Picpoul de Pinet, Les Girelles,** **£6.50** **£9.00** **£27.00**
Jean-Luc Colombo, France
 A rich, mouth-filling wine with notes of fresh flowers, melon and ripe summer stone fruit.

 *Full-flavoured, nutty, oaked white*

- 11. **Errázuriz Chardonnay, Aconcagua Costa, Chile** **£30.00**
 Lively aromas of lemon zest and lime blossom are underscored with hints of crisp pear and white flowers.

& Juicy, medium-bodied fruit-led red

- 12. **Monte Verde Merlot, Central Valley, Chile** £5.00 £6.50 £19.00
A supple and intensely juicy style with intense flavours of ripe red berries and plums.
- 13. **The Guv'nor, Spain, Felix Solis, Spain** £5.75 £7.50 £22.00
Shows plenty of rich, ripe, sweet red and dark fruit flavours and a juicy finish.
- 14. **Marqués de Morano Rioja Crianza, Spain** £26.00
Mazuelo adds a ripe cherry chunkiness to the smooth raspberries and cream style of Tempranillo.
- 15. **Denbies Redlands, England** £26.00
Crimson red in colour and loaded with red berry fruits, the medium-bodied dry palate is smooth and rich with a velvety texture.
- 16. **MMM Macho Man Monastrell, Jumilla, Casa Rojo, Spain** £8.00 £11.00 £33.00
Big, boisterous fruit-packed wine with rich berry flavours on a silky-smooth finish.

🍷 Sophisticated polished complex reds

- 17. **Château Notton, Margaux, France** £40.00
Ruby colour. Discreetly woody. Nose of ripe strawberry with blackcurrant and developing liquorice aromas. Rich, supple mouth. To be served with grilled meats and cheese.

🍷 Spicy, warming, peppery red

- 18. **Vine Trail Malbec, Rapel Valley, Chile** £5.75 £7.75 £23.00
Delicious, ripe red and black fruit flavours and a touch of spice.
- 19. **Salentein Barrel Selection Malbec Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina** £32.00
Notes of ripe blackberry, blueberry and redcurrant, with subtle hints of violet. The silky palate offers a crisp, balance backed by vanilla on the lingering finish.
- 20. **Bottega Ripasso Valpolicella Superiore DOC, Italy** £33.00
Dry, warm, balanced, with a pleasant and persistent aftertaste and light spicy notes.

🍷 Oaked intense, concentrated red

- 21. **Primus Carmenère, Colchagua Valley, Chile** £30.00
Richly flavoured, plum and blackberry mingling with exotic spice and dried fig.
- 22. **The Federalist 1776 Zinfandel, Lodi, USA** £35.00
Plum and cherry dominate, backed up by cinnamon spice: full-bodied, with a long smooth finish.

 *Dry, elegant rosé*

- 23. Monte Verde Merlot Rosé** £5.00 £6.50 £19.00
Central Valley, Chile
 Enough skin and juice contact for a superb colour, mouth-watering raspberry and blackcurrant flavours with fresh zing.
- 24. Vinuva Pinot Grigio Rosé, Venetie, Italy** £5.50 £7.00 £21.00
 A delicate pink wine full of fresh, summer-fruit aromas.

 *Rich, fruity rosé*

- 25. Denbies Rose Hill, England** £24.00
 A vibrant nose of summer fruits leading to a palate bursting with punnets of strawberries and raspberries, a hint of toffee apple and a persistent cassis finish.

 *Champagne & sparkling wine*

- 26. Galanti Prosecco Extra Dry, Italy** £7.00 £28.00
 Fine, persistent, soft fizz surrounds a fruit spectrum of apple, pear and a hint of peach. 125ml Bottle
 20cl mini bottle £9.00
- 27. Denbies Whitedowns Cuvee, England** £38.00
 This wine offers fresh citrus aromas with just a hint of brioche. The palate is crisp, dry and refreshing thanks to its finely balanced acidity. It has an enticing creamy texture and a persistent length of flavour.
- 28. Bottega Gold Prosecco Brut, Italy** £40.00
 Characteristic, fruity with scents of golden apple, Williams pear, acacia flowers and lily of the valley.
- 29. Bottega Rose Gold, Italy** £40.00
 Notes of mixed red berries alongside floral and white fruit aromas.
- 30. Montaudon Brut NV, France** £40.00
 A crisp and juicy cuvée, shows hints of peach and white flowers: the palate is fresh, fruity and well-balanced.
- 31. Jacquart Brut Mosaïque, France** £9.00 £50.00
 Shows notes of fresh pear, fig and almond, with hints of orange blossom and richer notes of honey and baked bread.
- 32. Taittinger Brut Réserve, France** £60.00
 The intensely fragrant character, subtle biscuity complexity and superb elegance is due to a predominance of Chardonnay in the blend. 37.5cl half bottle £38.00
