## *Welcome to Hartsfield Manor*

Hartsfield Manor was built in the 1860's by Arthur Woodriff Jaffray, as a family home. While Hartsfield was being built he rented Betchworth House in the village, but unfortunately he died in 1864 before the house was complete. He left a young widow who later gave birth to his daughter, Mary Arthur Jaffrey.

Although it has not been possible to discover the exact date of Hartsfield completion, we do know that by 1874 the house was occupied by Arthur Jaffrey's widow and her new husband, Captain James Gordon Moir.

The Moirs had six children, three of whom remained in the village and were known by many Betchworth villagers.

One happy memory of Hartsfield was of the coachman's daughter who was thought to be the prettiest girl in the village.

In the Second World War the house was taken over by the Canadian Army and used as a hospital. After the war the house was run for a time as a hotel, and later, was bought by Midland Bank as a Staff Training College. Internally many changes were made and several buildings were added.
